This is an amazing outreach event sponsored by the R3 Women's Ministry designed to reach girls in grades seven thru twelve with the power of the Gospel.
We believe girls need to be encouraged in their every day life to build healthy relationships and grow spiritually. They need to know they are loved by God and valued by their community, and they need safe place to have fun and ask questions about life and truth.

R3 Girls' Conference starts with a coffee bar & breakfast snacks and moves to worship & a message from Keely West, a young lady who was impacted by our very first Girls' Conference back in 2015! Girls will be able to attend two breakout sessions from the eight being offered. These breakout sessions discuss practical issues like friendships, Bible study, prayer and forgiveness, and are led by local women of various ages. Lunch is always a good time: homemade soup and sandwiches plus a very impressive dessert table followed by group games and fun! But our favorite part of the day is the Q&A session where girls ask life questions anonymously and get answers from real women based in God's Word.

From Pastor Jeff

"For in the Gospel the righteousness of God is revealed - a righteousness that is by faith from the first to the last, just as it is written: The righteous will live by faith." Psalm 65:4

We are now fully in the midst of our year of being Gospel Centered. Our theme verse highlights that the Gospel is all about the righteousness of God being revealed. We have seen God's righteousness being revealed this year, but when people think of the gospel in the context of church, the issue of growth always is a part of the conversation. The problem with this is that we only look at growth in the context of numbers. Do we have more people in church now than last week, last month or last year? There are a couple of huge problems with this perspective:

First, it shows we're looking at church with the world's view rather than God's. God is not nearly as interested in the numbers as you and I are. He is more concerned with reaching each individual with this great news for their lives than He is with getting their seat in a seat.

Second, God's view of success is very different than our view. Is success a number or are we more connected to God today than yesterday? More obedient? More generous? More willing to be stretched by Him? Those things should count more than numbers.

Third, focusing on numerical growth turns the church towards a business model and away from a family model. We are not people not seeking but rather seeking a closeness to God and each other.

Finally, growth-centeredness cheapens the mission and love of God. We are to seek to make Him known,

not seek to get more from Him. It is a shift from getting to giving.

We are not sharing in order to get more people into church because we want to be the biggest church around... Or because we are afraid of what might happen to the church if no one new comes in... Or because we feel it some kind of religious obligation commanded in Scripture. No! We are sharing because we have such an incredible God who created and loves us and made a way for us to know Him! He wants to commune with us and show us who He is and how we can know Him more. The Gospel is about Him!

That is why the church motto is so important for us to remember:

To KNOW Christ and To make HIM known.
