# **From Pastor Jeff**


"For our momentary light affliction is producing for us an absolutely incomparable eternal weight of glory." 2 Cor. 4:17

First, it has elevated our desire to be in **community** with each other. I miss you guys! But instead of wallowing in that negative feeling, I have begun to anticipate our reunion and are getting things in motion to celebrate that day! The people I have seen during this time have been a blessing to sit and talk with (from six feet away). I relish the moments we have had, and I look forward to more of that.

#### **From Fear to Forgiveness**

In the evening of that first day of the week, the disciples were gathered together with the doors locked because of their fear of the Jews. Then Jesus came, stood among them, and said to them, "Peace to you!" Having said this, He showed them His hands and His side. So the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you." After saying this, He breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." John 20:19-23Fear has spread across our great nation and the globe. All over the world people are locked away from each other. Like our current situation the disciples also locked themselves away in fear after the death of Christ. They feared the Jews might come for them next. But Jesus did not stay dead, He walked out of the grave and through the locked room of the disciples. He brought them peace when they had fear.
