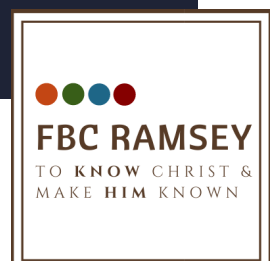

From Pastor Jeff

“Consider the work of God; for who can straighten out what He has made crooked? In the day of prosperity be joyful, but in the day of adversity, consider: without question, God has made the one as well as the other, so that man cannot discover anything that will come after him.” *Ecclesiastes 7:13-14*

We have a tendency to lump worship and praise together. However, they are really very different. *Worship is expressing our thanks to God for who He is.* This is part of what we did last year. In rediscovering God, we learned more about His nature and character, and it moved us in our music, our service, our giving, and even our decisions.

Praise is thanking God for what He has done. It is recognizing the acts and hand of God and expressing our thanks to Him for it. We do that in many ways which are similar to how we respond to Him in worship, but there is one aspect of our praise we may not have thought about. 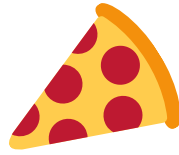

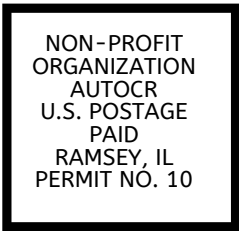
