

"Through Him then, let's continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips praising His name." - Hebrews 13:15

As I was reading this phrasing, it struck me as interesting, "sacrifice of praise". They seem to be opposites or a contradiction of terms. A sacrifice costs us something. It is a gift which is given that you probably wouldn't have given on your own. But because of a greater purpose or a greater blessing we give it anyway.

Praise seems easy for us. It is simply a thank you to God for what He has done. It is acknowledging through word and deed that God's hand has been at work in and around us. So, on the surface, these do not seem to belong with each other.

But there are times, which we all go through, which praise is the last thing on our minds. We want to focus on all the things we wanted Him to do. We linger and get stuck in our disappointments and expectations of what we thought God should do that it becomes difficult if not seemingly impossible for us to shift our eyes to the things He has done.

Then this phrase becomes a little clearer. When you don't feel like singing, do it anyway. When you don't feel like looking past what you envisioned, look and see what God actually has done. When disappointment and frustration cloud the joy in your life, force yourself to look past the fog and offer up a service of praise. Easy words, but how in the world are we supposed to do that?

The first 2 words are the key. Through Him. He doesn't leave you floundering on your own and just expect you to figure it out. He is with you and will help you see what He has done. He loves to show us what He has done, because it reveals more of who He is. So, lift up that voice, lift up those eyes, lift up those hands because He is worthy of our praise no matter how you feel right now.

FROM PASTOR MATT

It feels as if we have been here at FBC Ramsey for longer than two months. I have jumped headfirst into ministry and working on building a solid foundation for future ministry. I have been on a mission trip, held a few youth group meetings, and served as a camp director. Through all the busyness of ministry though, I have seen God's glory, time and time again and God is good!

Fourteen students, along with us four adults, had a great time serving the Lord and the people of Cincinnati. I was so impressed by everyone's attitude, willingness, and faithfulness. Besides digging the trench and general restocking work in the Market, the Splash Bash that we organized and hosted on Saturday connected with about 130 kids and families in the community. Sunday, we served about 75 families through pickup and deliveries, which equaled about 375 people. Also, the money we raised through VBS will feed 100 families for 5 weeks.

As camp director for the Rehoboth Older Boys Camp, we used Ecclesiastes 4:12b to lead us to the theme of Connected. Being Connected to God, Connected as the Church, and Connected to sharing the Gospel of Jesus to the Community. The students were great, my volunteers and workers were excellent, the weather was beautiful, and God directed it all.

Looking forward to the month of August and the beginning of the school year, I ask you to begin to pray. Pray for the school administration, school staff, school support staff, coaches, and school volunteers as they continue to prepare, plan, and then present. Pray for the students as they prepare to learn, plan for the future, and execute in the present. We will be hosting a prayer service for our school district at 6pm on August 14, 2022, at the Ramsey School Building. We will also be serving our Ramsey School District Staff lunch on August 17, 2022.

Before the school starts though, the youth are invited to our Summer EXTRAvaganza. It is going to be a BIG event with BIG fun! It will start at 10:30am on August 13, 2022 and lunch will be provided. Invite your friends, invite your neighbors, in fact invite all the 7th through 12th graders you know, to a BIG experience right before school kicks off.
