That's when she looked at me and through muffled laughter, told me they had been there, right in front of me, for weeks!!!

What!?! I couldn't believe it! No way they have been there this whole time. How could I have missed them? Then I began looking on the table wondering what else I had missed.

It is amazing how often this happens in our everyday lives and in our spiritual lives as well. I am constantly rereading Scriptures to discover things which were hidden in plain sight. I have discovered so much in the past couple years in stories that I would have swore I knew inside and out. This realization has compelled me to search even more to find out what else I missed.

But this can happen with people too. So often we get used to seeing someone and it is easy to miss signs of an unspoken need. Whether it is prayer, encouragement or some other kind of help. How often we pass people by because 1. we don't notice or 2. we are too wrapped up in our own problems.

In all of this, the key here is this: we must slow down and see what God has put in front of us, and allow Jesus to touch us so that we can see everything clearly. We simply need to humble ourselves before Him and let Him work in us.
